

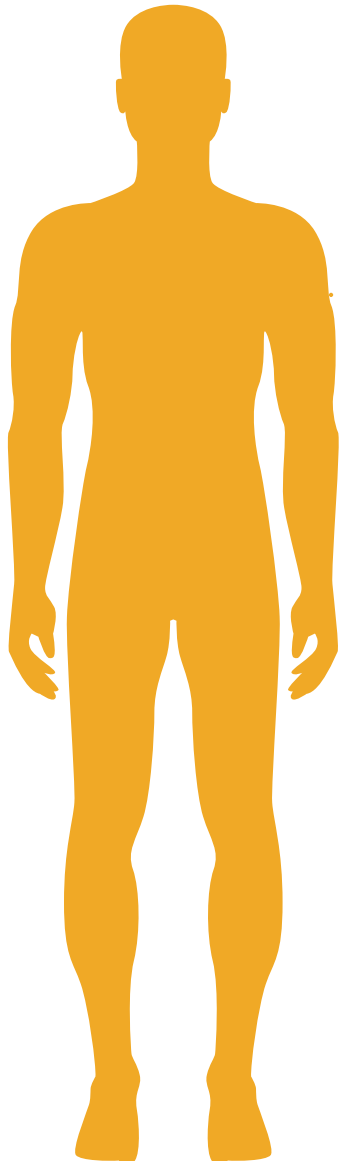

31% **Cancer**

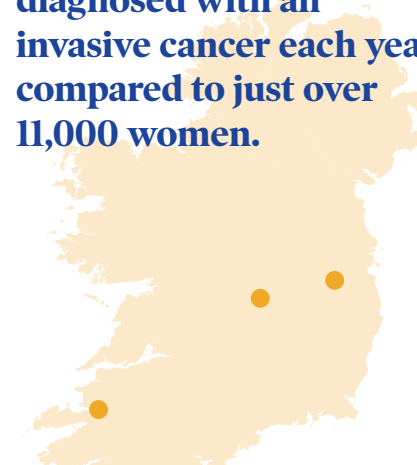
30% Cardiovascular Diseases

13% Respiratory Diseases

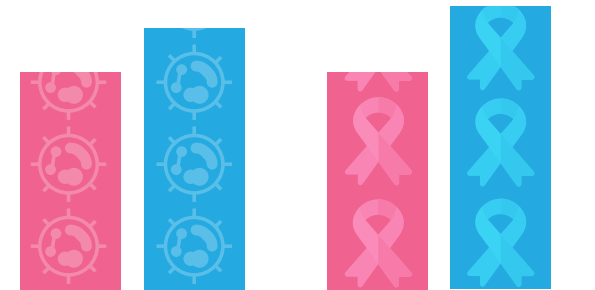
